LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION CLASS
 This American Red Cross class is for ages 15 and older. Successful completion will allow participants to receive a two year certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid and CPR/AED. All participants must pass the prerequisite swim test administered on May 23. This test consists of a continuous 300 yard swim (front crawl and breast stroke with proper technique required), retrieval of a ten pound weight from a depth of 9 feet, and two minutes of treading water not using arms. *Internet access for offsite instruction is needed. Attendance is mandatory to complete course.*

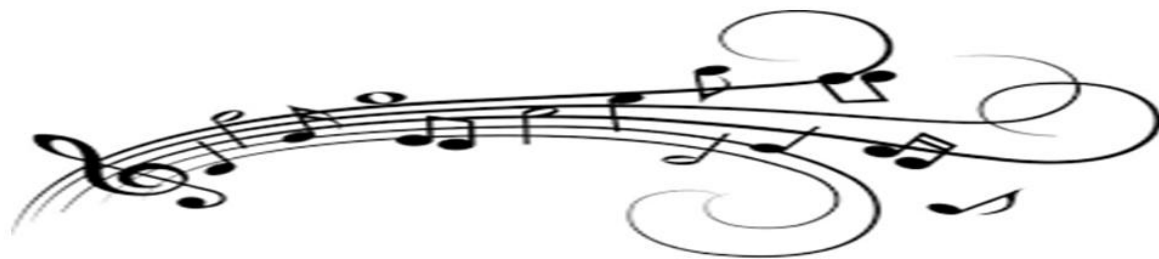
